### Tips for Saving Energy and Money



- Set your thermostat at 68 to 70 degrees in the winter and at 78 to 80 degrees in the summer.
- Check and seal duct leaks.
- Repair hot water leaks immediately.
- Keep appliances clean and in good working order.
- Shade east and west windows.
- Install high-efficiency, low-volume shower heads.
- Turn off any unnecessary appliances.
- Consider using a programmable thermostat or set your thermostat down 10 degrees in the winter or up 10 degrees in the summer when you leave home for four hours or longer.
- Change your air filters and clean the coils of your heating and cooling system regularly.
- Kitchen lights are typically on quite a bit, so choose styles that use less energy, such as compact fluorescent lights.
