Switching Your Energy Supplier?



Visit www.WattsNewCT.com for the latest information about companies offering alternative electricity supplies to UI's residential and business customers. If you should **switch** to a different supplier, UI would still deliver your electricity and be responsible for all billing. Your Point of Delivery (POD) identification number is a 13-digit number unique to your electrical account. You will need your POD ID if you choose to switch to a different energy supplier. Your POD ID number is located on your monthly utility statement directly below the heading **"New Charges and Credit"**. Also, you can find your POD ID number on the bottom of your statement in the box labeled, **"Electricity Usage."**

Please note: Your UI account number **is not** your POD ID.
