- h. Work with CT DEEP on any comments for the Scope of Study for English Station Eastern Interior Boilers 1 through 12 and High Pressure Boilers 13 & 14 on hazardous building materials.
- i. Finalize investigation report for Western Portion environmental media and hazardous building materials results
- j. Continue to develop investigation report representing Eastern Portion of English Station Interior Boiler 1 through 12 environmental media only
- k. Continue to develop investigation report representing English Station Interior Boiler 13/14 environmental media only
- l. Begin to consolidate data and develop site-wide groundwater remedy.
