

## The United Illuminating Company OASIS Timing Requirements for Point-to-Point Transmission Service

**A.** The United Illuminating Company (UI) OASIS Reservation Timing Requirements for **Firm and Non-Firm Transmission Service over the Phase I/II HVDC**Transmission facilities in accordance with Part II of ISO New England Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, Schedule 20A, Section 4.2(a). <sup>1</sup>

One year or longer – Shall be submitted no earlier than sixty (60) days in advance of the calendar month in which service is to commence.

Monthly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 60 days before service is to commence. Weekly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 21 days before service is to commence. Daily - Shall be submitted no earlier than 21 days before service is to commence. Hourly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 21 days before service is to commence.

**B.** UI OASIS Reservation Timing Requirements for **Firm Local Point-to-Point Transmission Service** are in accordance with Part II of ISO New England Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, Schedule 21, Section 5(a). <sup>1</sup>

One year or longer – Shall be submitted no earlier than sixty (60) days in advance of the calendar month in which service is to commence.

Less than one year - Shall be subject to expedited procedures that shall be negotiated between UI and the Eligible customer within time constraints provided in the applicable Local Service Schedule.

C. UI OASIS Reservation Timing Requirements for Non-Firm Local Point-to-Point Transmission Service are in accordance with Part II of ISO New England Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, Schedule 21, Section 6(c). 1

Monthly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 60 days before service is to commence.

Weekly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 14 days before service is to commence.

Daily - Shall be submitted no earlier than 2 days before service is to commence.

Hourly - Shall be submitted no earlier than noon the day before service is to commence. Requests for service received later than 2:00 p.m. prior to the day service is scheduled to commence will be accommodated if practicable.
