



## **The United Illuminating Company** **OASIS Timing Requirements for Point-to-Point Transmission Service**

- A. The United Illuminating Company (UI) OASIS Reservation Timing Requirements for Firm and Non-Firm Transmission Service over the Phase I/II HVDC** Transmission facilities in accordance with Part II of ISO New England Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, Schedule 20A, Section 4.2(a).<sup>1</sup>

One year or longer – Shall be submitted no earlier than sixty (60) days in advance of the calendar month in which service is to commence.

Monthly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 60 days before service is to commence.

Weekly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 21 days before service is to commence.

Daily - Shall be submitted no earlier than 21 days before service is to commence.

Hourly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 21 days before service is to commence.

- B. UI OASIS Reservation Timing Requirements for Firm Local Point-to-Point Transmission Service** are in accordance with Part II of ISO New England Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, Schedule 21, Section 5(a).<sup>1</sup>

One year or longer – Shall be submitted no earlier than sixty (60) days in advance of the calendar month in which service is to commence.

Less than one year - Shall be subject to expedited procedures that shall be negotiated between UI and the Eligible customer within time constraints provided in the applicable Local Service Schedule.

- C. UI OASIS Reservation Timing Requirements for Non-Firm Local Point-to-Point Transmission Service** are in accordance with Part II of ISO New England Transmission, Markets and Services Tariff, Schedule 21, Section 6(c).<sup>1</sup>

Monthly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 60 days before service is to commence.

Weekly - Shall be submitted no earlier than 14 days before service is to commence.

Daily - Shall be submitted no earlier than 2 days before service is to commence.

Hourly - Shall be submitted no earlier than noon the day before service is to commence. Requests for service received later than 2:00 p.m. prior to the day service is scheduled to commence will be accommodated if practicable.
